During fall of 2019, excelled and collaborated with Tera Helfer in an incredible mentorship with Cartoon Network, with an emphasis on cinematography. Using children’s action, drama, and emotional storytelling proficiency in the style of Quentin Blake, created and revised a 4.5-minute sequence of *Veruca in the Nut Room* from *Charlie and the Chocolate Factory*. I even completed a follow up to this sequence, called *Good-bye Violet*.

Based on a Broadway musical, created storyboard panels as thumbnails, developed roughs, and delivered high-quality finished storyboard sequences. Cleaned up the rough panels, addressing the action and body movement, in Storyboard Pro on a Wacom Cintiq.
